

Hitachi and BANDAI NAMCO Demonstrate Fonix Speech Technology at WIRED NextFest™ 2007

The Fonix DECTalk TTS technology used in the demonstration was previously used by BANDAI NAMCO to develop the TalkingAid Wireless device. The Talking Aid, which was introduced to the assistive market in late 2006, is a portable communication aid designed to help persons with hearing and speech impairments.
